SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

\$1000.00 each for 2018

ANNETTE PHELPS LINCOLN SCHOLARSHIP: Named in honor of the first president of the Ohio Federation of Women's Clubs, this scholarship is available to graduating high school seniors to use in securing education in the **Teaching or Library** professions at an Ohio college or university of the student's choice.

ART SCHOLARSHIP: This scholarship is available to a graduating high school senior who will attend an accredited college, university or art school in Ohio. An **ORIGINAL** piece of art must be delivered to the GFWC/Ohio Federation of Women's Club's Annual Convention Art Exhibit Room no later than 9:00 A.M. on the first day of convention. **The applicant's name, address, phone number and the name of the sponsoring club and the contact person from that club must be securely attached to the back of the artwork.**

ELAINE WEINMAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP: This scholarship is available to a graduating high school senior for use in securing an education beyond high school in the field of **Communications**, limited to radio, television, drama, speech or journalism, from an accredited Ohio college, university or technical school.

ETHEL G. SWANBECK ALLIED HEALTH SCHOLARSHIP: This scholarship is available to a graduating high school senior pursuing a course in the study of an **Allied Health Field** at an Ohio college or university of the student's choice. The applicant may use the scholarship for a degree as a doctor, nurse, pharmacist, veterinarian, X-ray technician, laboratory technician, etc.

CLUBWOMAN SCHOLARSHIP (JUNIORETTE APPLICANTS): This scholarship is available to a graduating high school senior who is at least a 3 year member of a Juniorette club federated in the GFWC/Ohio Federation of Women's Clubs.

CLUBWOMAN SCHOLARSHIP (GENERAL AND JUNIOR APPLICANTS): This scholarship is for those clubwomen who need additional education or training to join or advance in the work force or to provide for themselves and/or their families. A minimum of 3 years membership in a General or Junior club federated in the GFWC/Ohio Federation of Women's Clubs is required. There is a separate application for general and junior clubwomen.

REQUIRED MATERIAL

I. FROM THE SPONSORING CLUB:

1. A letter of recommendation from a club officer or club scholarship chairman giving a character reference, unusual financial obligations, chronic illness or disabilities within the family, work experience of the applicant, etc. The club's letter must describe the applicant's club activities, her length of membership and her leadership roles in the club. The letter **MUST** list the names and contact information for the club's president and scholarship chairman.

II. FROM THE APPLICANT:

1. An official copy of the student's transcript which must include class rank and grade point average provided by counselor. *The student must have a grade point average of 3.0 or better. (Art Scholarship applicants must have a g.p.a. of 2.6 or better.)*
2. Letter of recommendation from counselor, high school principal, administrator or teacher. (Art Scholarship applicants **must** have a letter of recommendation from an art teacher.)
3. Copy of letter of acceptance from an **Ohio** college or university on official school letterhead.

4. Letter written by applicant establishing proof of financial need, including any financial aid applied for and being received
5. Essay – Why are you choosing this line of study and what have you been doing to learn more about it. (example- job shadow, mentor, classes, school projects)?
6. Essay – What community service project have you completed that impacted the community and your own life?
7. Copy of completed GFWC/Ohio Federation of Women's Club Supplemental Questionnaire.
8. Completed and signed application form.

III. QUALIFYING FACTORS FOR ART SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANT'S ARTWORK:

1. Media: oils, watercolor, pastel, acrylic, pen and ink, pencil or charcoal.
2. Size not to exceed 20" x 24" unmatted.
3. Frames: Oil, if framed, must have simple frames, such as molding; other media should be matted. **NO GLASS.**
4. **NO REPRODUCTIONS.** No portraits, cartoons or posters. Graphics, if entered, must be the original drawing or painting. Any entry that appears to be copied will be disqualified.

CAREFULLY FOLLOW THESE DIRECTIONS

1. Student should assemble the eight (8) pieces of required materials and submit to counselor or sponsoring club. Any omission(s) automatically disqualify the applicant.
2. Club scholarship chairman should collect the required materials and send with the sponsoring club's letter of recommendation to the Chairman of the Scholarship Trustees postmarked **no later than March 1st**.
3. Art Scholarship applicant's artwork must be delivered to OFWC Convention Art Exhibit Room no later than 9:00 AM on the first day of Convention.

GENERAL INFORMATION: Immediately following the GFWC Annual Meeting (Convention), the Chairman of the Scholarship Board of Trustees will notify those students receiving scholarships as well as the sponsoring clubs. Checks will be mailed by the Treasurer of the GFWC/Ohio Federation of Women's Clubs no later than September 1 to those receiving scholarships. **Applicant must notify the GFWC/Ohio Federation of Women's Clubs Scholarship Board of Trustees Chairman by June 30 of decision to accept/reject the scholarship.**
