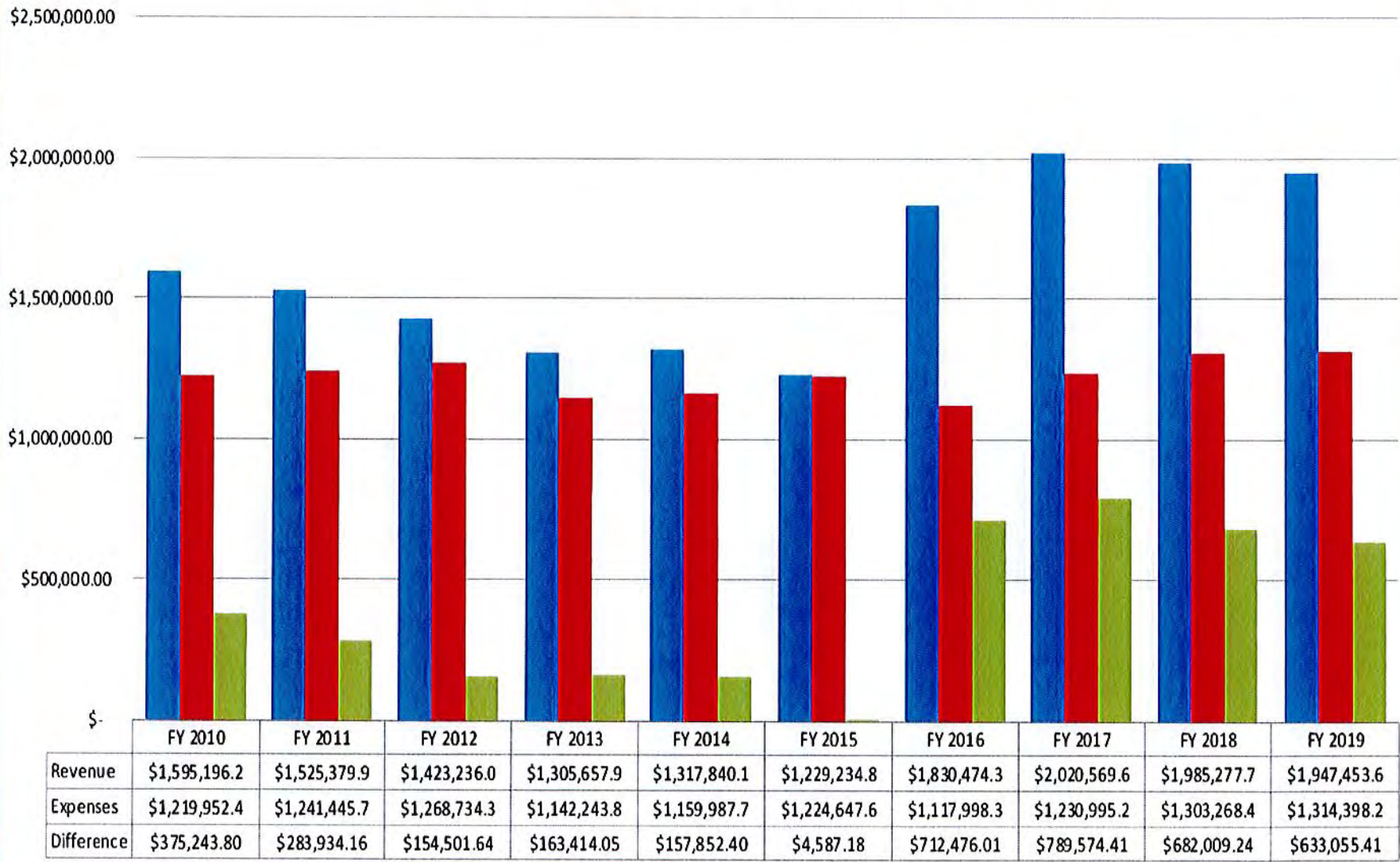

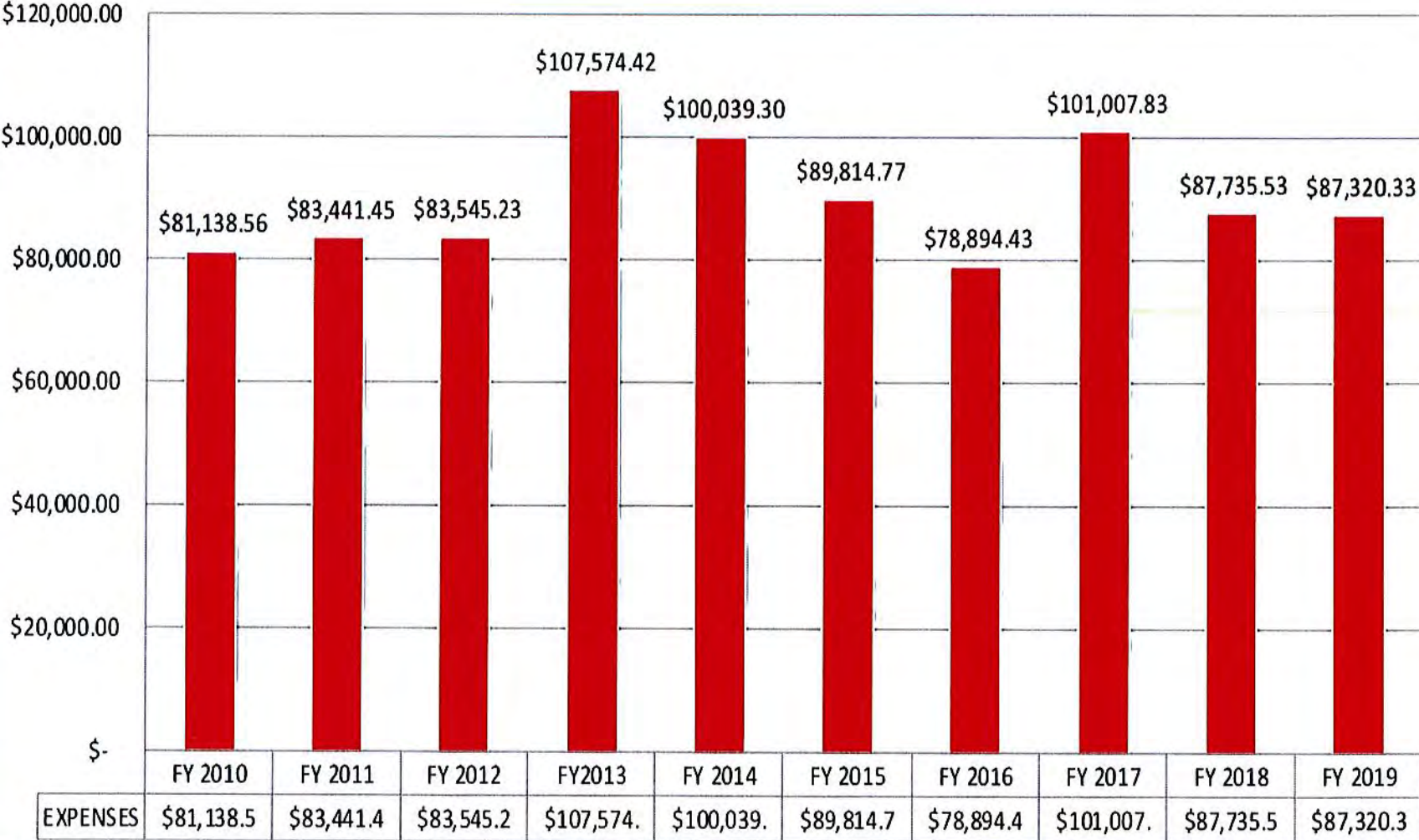
### General Fund Totals as of August - 10 Year Comparison



■ Revenue ■ Expenses ■ Difference

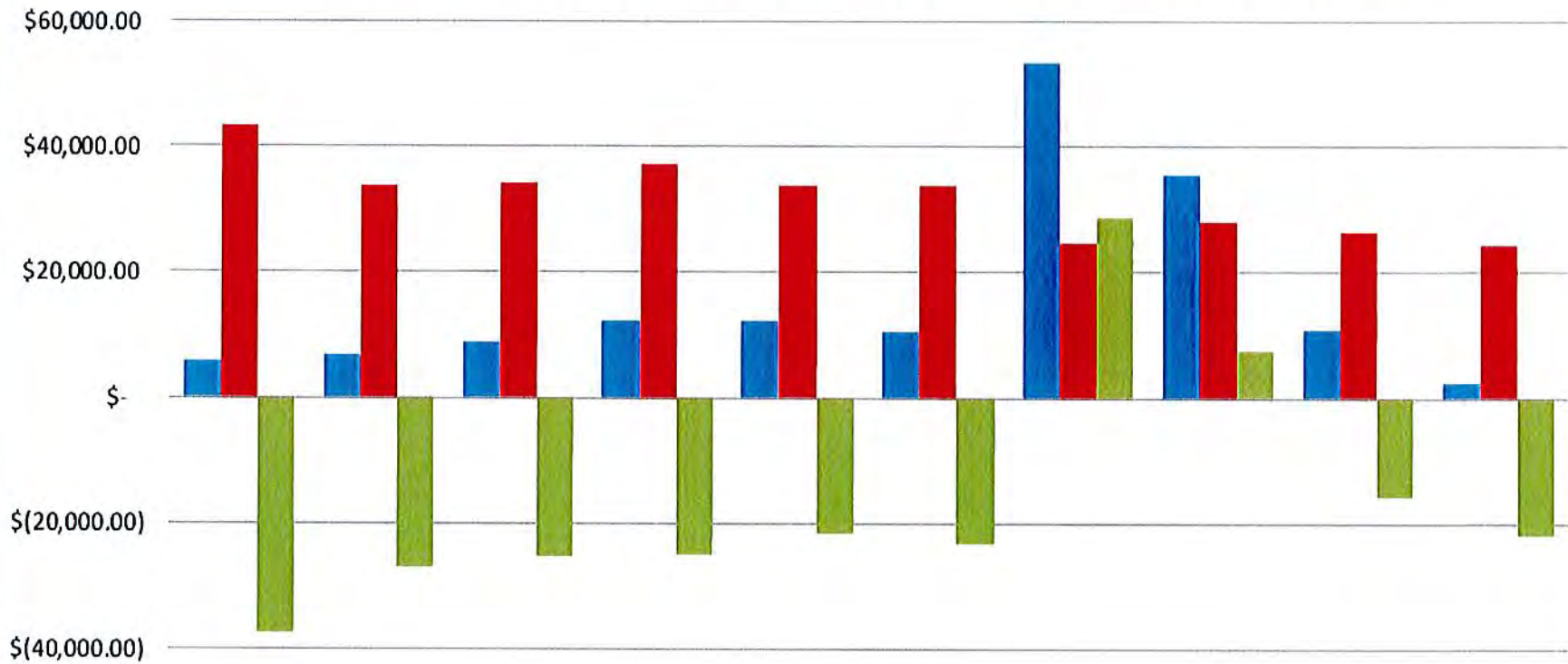


### Transportation Total Expenses Comparison as of August - 10 Year Comparison
