Aimee called the meeting to order. 8 members in attendance

Officer's Reports

- **President** – Aimee Letcher
- **Secretary** – Sarah Moyer
- **Treasurer** – Kate Bailey – \$16,210.72 in PTO Account \$4,802.71 in DI Account

- **Book Fair** – went well, \$5,288.77 in sales, \$2,644.38 in scholastic dollars (we have roughly \$3,000 in scholastic account) Megan purchased a book for every student to be distributed in May
 - Kate has list of teacher books they want – we will purchase
- **Last Day of School 5/27**
 - Bounce House Booked – comes with 4 bounce houses
 - Need 10 -12 volunteers for all day
 - Rita's Italian Ice - \$2.70/serving – coming from 12-2pm
- **Skating Parties** – about \$30 loss from presale tickets
 - Schedule 2 for next year (October and January) – do presale tickets again, Wednesday nights from 6-8pm at Olympic fun center – also open this up to middle school students
- **4th Grade Farwell** – Sarah & Carrie – Knightline Embroidery in Girard, OH (31 kids total)
 - Shirts (\$8 EACH) – 2030 on back with student signatures, Be Brave, Be Bold, Be Fearless on front
 - Bags (\$5 EACH) – Be Bold, Be Brave, Be Fearless on bags
 - Pop Its – donated by Carrie Earls
- **Awards Ceremony** – Most teachers are doing their own thing – provided a few coupons for Student of the months for 2nd grade, as well as 2 math-based books and 2 3rd grade reading level books for most improved in those two areas (reading/math)
- **Field Day** – May 12th – Julie
 - need more volunteers – send out final forms – sent out on remind.
 - Layout and full event of activities emailed to the teachers
- **Popcorn Fundraiser** – end of April through beginning of May
 - Extended invitation to Middle School – they will be doing dine to donate so they declined
- **Teacher Week** – 5/2 – 5/6
 - Monday – breakfast – panera bagels, fruit salad, yogurts, oneills coffee and tea
 - Purchased toaster oven for teacher lounge
 - FUTURE – B&K farm 7# fruit bowl - \$4.50/# feeds 15-30 people
 - Tuesday – snacks
 - Wednesday – gift - monogrammed clipboards – Chelsea made (reach out to find out if we can get student teachers theirs)
 - Thursday – Catered lunch from Cockeye BBQ – Kate to deliver, Carrie to clean up
 - Friday – Cockeye Creamery Ice cream - \$3.70/ 6oz serving – comes already in cups to put in freezer
- **YLIVE concert @ covelli center** – Luke Bryan – asking for nonprofits to work their beer and wine tents (adults only) – Saturday July 16th – make 10% profit of net sales from tent – 15-20 people needed
 - Kate, Aimee, Megan, Sherry, Gwen, Chelsea, Lindsey D, Amanda

- Open to middle school to split profits based upon middle school people volunteering to help – or see about middle school manning their own tent for their own profits?
- Ask administration approval about “Badger PTO” shirts to be made (Chelsea) – ask if they can be worn at the event (Gough and Hamilton)
