

MATHEWS & BADGER – 3RD ANNUAL BIGGEST DEER CONTEST

in conjunction with the Trumbull County Sheriff's Office



The Mathews and Badger Local School Districts are excited to announce the 3rd annual biggest deer contest. The goal of the contest is to provide Mathews and Badger students with a friendly opportunity to showcase their hunting talents. There is NO entry fee. All prizes have been donated by the community.

- 1) Must be a student of the Mathews or Badger School District.
- 2) The deer must be harvested legally and in free range in Ohio or Pennsylvania between September 25, 2022, and February 5, 2023. Students must present a copy of the tag.
- 3) Only 1 deer per student (If the student gets more than 1 deer, the heavier one may be substituted.)
- 4) The contest will be based on weight (buck or doe.) The weight will be kept a secret until the day of the drawing. We will also have a big buck contest based on inches.
- 5) Although we want this to be a family event, the student must pull the trigger, release the arrow, etc.
- 6) Students must present a signed piece of paper from the processing company that lists the weight of the deer along with the child's name. If the student/family chooses to self-process the deer, a weigh station will be available. (This will be the only one used for self-processors.)
- 7) You must submit a picture of the student and the deer. We want to advertise this event and save memories for bragging rights!
- 8) **STUDENTS MUST OBEY HUNTING LAWS AND REGULATIONS WHEN HUNTING. ALSO, NO WEAPONS ARE PERMITTED ON SCHOOL PROPERTY.**

THE CONTEST:

- 1) The contest will be for post-gutted weight. Pounds and ounces. In case of a tie, a coin flip will be used.

AGE BRACKETS:

8 TO 11 YEARS OLD: 1st - 2ND AND 3RD PLACE

12 TO 15 YEARS OLD: 1st - 2ND AND 3RD PLACE

16 TO 19 YEARS OLD: 1st - 2ND AND 3RD PLACE

- There will also be a big buck contest, based on the deer's rack, for students ages 8 to 19.
- Prizes and trophies will be awarded at a banquet after the completion of the contest.
